



HB 404- Vote YES –NEW Compromise- Vote YES

- -Teamsters Union agreed to the delivery of packages by electric delivery vehicles that have been modified for safety as desired and **via the Teamster national labor contract**.
- -Teamsters **National Master Agreement** on Labor <u>already allows</u> for the delivery of packages via electric carts and that language and is intended for use in small communities where electric carts are a normal form of transportation.
- -Already used successfully in several states like Florida.
- -Very safe and modified for weather and delivery.
- -For Kentucky, it will be used in neighborhoods like Norton Commons in Louisville when it makes sense during heavy Christmas season deliveries.
- -Used only in peak times of heavy deliveries i.e. to deliver Christmas presents.
- -Electric cart must be driven by full time well trained employee, per company policy
